OVERVIEW

EVENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

RTD 1

- Anyone entering the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival declares to have accepted these Terms and Conditions by purchasing an admission ticket.
- Anyone who fails to abide by these Terms and Conditions may be denied admission to the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival or may be removed from the festival grounds. Non-compliance with the Terms and Conditions gives the Company the right to deny admission to the Rocking the

Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival for the next 5 (five) years.

RTD 2

- Anyone who wishes to enter the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival must possess a valid admission ticket and valid ID.
- A Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival admission ticket grants 1 (one) person admission on the day or days for which an admission ticket is purchased. All visitors possessing a Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival admission ticket enter the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds at their own risk.
- The minimum age for Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival is 18 (eighteen) years.
- Faking or forging Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival admission tickets is subject to criminal prosecution.

RTD 3

- Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival tickets are neither refunded nor exchanged for another type of ticket.
- In case of loss or theft the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival ticket will neither be replaced nor refunded.

RTD 4

- All registered, valid and activated Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival tickets must be scanned upon entering the festival grounds and/or camping site.
- The Company and/or official ticket seller reserve the right to verify the identity of the festival visitors upon entering the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds. Visitor/s who do not possess a valid proof of identity will be denied admission to the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds, without entitlement to a refund of the entrance fee. Valid proofs of identity are: a valid ID, passport or driver's license. A temporary identification will only be accepted, if you have a valid affidavit to accompany it.
- Loss or theft of an admission ticket will not give entitlement to a refund of the entrance fee.

RTD 5

Admission to the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds is prohibited or may be refused or denied (without entitlement to a refund of the entrance fee) if a visitor (the following list is non-exhaustive):

- is under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
- is in the possession of or deals in drugs;
- was previously refused admission to other events / meetings by the Company or other authorities;
- shows behaviour which manifestly hints at an intention to disturb the peace or to provoke, by inciting to violence, hate, rage, etc.;
- puts the lives of other visitors at risk;
- is in the possession of banned objects;

- refuses to be searched/patted down by security personnel; and
- refuses or fails to abide by the Terms and Conditions

RTD 6

- Visitors may be searched or patted down by security personnel before being allowed admission to Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival.
- Security personnel may ask ticket holders of the same sex to subject to a pat down and/or search their clothes and luggage in order to intercept banned objects. If any banned objects are found, the security personnel will be entitled to confiscate the object and to refuse the owner thereof admission to the festival.

RTD 7

• Inspection at the gates will be in accordance with the applicable laws and is aimed at finding weapons or hazardous objects which, if brought on the festival grounds, may put the proper course of Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival at risk or otherwise endanger the safety of the public.

The following objects and actions are not allowed at the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds:

- alcohol / alcohol will only be allowed at the campsite;
- animals (except guide dogs);
- fires / skottles / gas;
- glass;
- professional photography equipment unless prior consent is given by the Company (this includes zoom lenses);
- under 18's;
- swimming after dark;
- illegal substances;
- drugs or other mind-enhancing substances;
- projectiles or explosives in solid, liquid or gas form;
- flammable products or materials & aerosol cans;
- pyrotechnical objects (fireworks, torches, etc.);
- all weapons and other potentially hazardous or sharp objects (sticks, chains, knives, etc.);
- banners or other objects with discriminatory and/or provocative texts and/or expressions that may be used to disturb the peace, put the safety of the other visitors at risk, and/or damage goods and injure people; and
- drones.

RTD 8

Visitors to Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival are not allowed to:

- climb on tents, constructions, fences, light bridges, benches, or any other structures on the grounds;
- block entrances, exits and emergency exits;
- disguise themselves in order to make themselves unrecognisable with the intention to disturb the peace or put the safety of the other visitors at risk;

- sell food, drinks or other products without the express permission of the Company;
- throw or shoot objects in solid, liquid or gas form;
- smoke where smoking is banned;
- urinate in public;
- park a vehicle without an official parking sticker issued by the Company. Vehicles may be towed at the owner's expense;
- tearing down, breaking, or trashing decorations; and
- make fires.

RTD 9

- Wearing texts, symbols, objects, clothes and/or other (visible) external expressions explicitly representing a political, social movement or group is prohibited. Anything that hints of discrimination, incitement, or racism is strictly prohibited.
- Ambush marketing and brand hijacking is strictly prohibited.

RTD 10

- To ensure the public order and safety during the festival, all those present at the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds are obliged to obey the instructions and directions given by the Company or the person designated to give instructions or directions on the festival grounds and/or camping site at all times.

RTD 11

For safety reasons the Company reserves the right:

- to interrupt or discontinue the festival;
- to prevent visitors at the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds from leaving the festival grounds until further notice;
- to ask visitors to leave the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds;
- to refuse visitors admission to the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds, even if they possess a valid admission ticket.

The Company may find itself forced to change or alter the festival programme. In this event the admission ticket will remain valid but no entrance fee will be refunded or exchanged.

RTD 12

By entering the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds all visitors automatically consent to being photographed and/or filmed and to the resulting digital images being used or broadcasted by the Company. The Company may use these digital images for promotional and/or commercial purposes related to Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival, including with regard to all commercial and media partners.

If a visitor objects to his/her personal data being used for promotional and

commercial purposes, he/she may submit, at no cost, a written request to the Company to stop this use.

Visitors are not allowed to use pictures taken and/or films made by them at the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds for commercial or publicity purposes without the prior written permission of the Company.

RTD 13

· All visitors of Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival are consequently obliged to help keep the festival grounds clean, among other things by using the rubbish bins on the festival grounds, camping sites and on the parking lots.

RTD 14

· The distribution of flyers or putting up posters in or outside the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds during the festival is prohibited.

RTD 15

The Company applies a zero-tolerance policy with regard to drugs.

Using, dealing in or the possession of drugs on the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds is strictly prohibited. If proof hereof is found, through strict surveillance and inspection, the person involved will be expelled from the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds and denied admission for a period of 5 (five) consecutive years.

If a visitor is prescribed certain drugs for health reasons, he/she must present a valid medical certificate before being allowed to bring the specific drugs on the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival grounds.

All directions and instructions given by the security personnel must be obeyed immediately. If possession of banned or dangerous weapons is suspected, the security personnel will be entitled to make a search. Refusal to submit to a search may result in being expelled from the festival.

RTD 16

• All Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival Merchandise is solely officially offered for sale on the festival grounds and applicable retail online store.

RTD 17

All "Intellectual Property" in respect of the Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival is owned by the Company, which includes all and any of the rights in and to (without limitation) the rights in and to domain names, websites, all social media pages, trade-marks, service marks, trade names, logos, recipes, patents, production methods, inventions (whether patentable or not), presentations, training manuals, flow-diagrams, schematics, plans, diagrams, wire-frames, screen shots, know-how (including confidential industrial and commercial information and techniques in any form), utility models, registered and unregistered design rights, copyright, semi-

conductor topography rights, database rights, rights in respect of any new or existing compilation of any data or information not covered under any existing copyright, any structured analysis, reports, application and any resulting know-how, use or any other results originating or following from or as a consequence of data being made available in respect of any of the aforementioned or part thereof, and all similar proprietary rights which may subsist in any part of the world including, where such rights are obtained or enhanced by registration, any registration of such rights and applications and rights to apply for such registrations.

PRIVACY POLICY

OVERVIEW

Welcome to the privacy policy (the "**Policy**") of Rocking the Daisies Music and Lifestyle Festival, by Steyn Events (Pty) Ltd (the "**Company**").

INFORMATION

The Company maintains the privacy of its online users and does not collect any personal or private information from users of its Digital Services unless they knowingly and voluntarily provide this information.

The Company does not distribute this personal information to any 3rd party unless it is informed to do so by the said 3rd party or is required in terms of law.

WHEN YOU MAKE A PURCHASE

Some of our Digital Services may enable you to buy tickets or make other purchases. Some purchases on our Digital Services or on our premises are handled directly by the Company and others are managed and processed by a third party service provider. We or third party service providers may collect Personal Information when you make purchases through our Digital Services. If you are purchasing tickets through third parties on our Digital Services, some or all of your purchase may be processed by a third party, tickets may be issued and managed by that third party, and your Personal Information will be subject to the policies of that third party.

We or the third party service provider use purchase information in order to administer, manage and correspond with you about your purchase, and may also

add your Personal Information to either of our databases in order to inform you of upcoming events, offers or other information that may be of interest to you. The Company sometimes makes use of cookies. Cookies are mainly used for our website to remember visitors. The purpose of remembering a user is to not ask a user the same question every visit.

A user/subscriber is able to amend or set controls on its internet web browser or alternatively use a programme or application to control the use of cookies by any website. Session cookies should be deleted from your computer when you close your browser. Persistent cookies will remain stored on your computer until deleted, or until they reach a specified expiry date.

WHEN YOU ACCESS OUR WIFI AT ROCKING THE DAISIES MUSIC AND LIFESTYLE FESTIVAL

Our Wi-Fi network is public and unencrypted and provided by a third party – telecommunications/network provider. Use of this network is at your own risk.

THIRD PARTY SITES AND SERVICES

As described above, our Digital Services include features, functionality, or offers (such as ticket purchases, promotions, surveys, etc.) provided by third parties, and may also contain links to third party advertisers and others. When you make purchases through third parties, we do not receive or store your payment account information, as the purchase and payment transaction is processed by the third party.
